

General Terms and Conditions

Study trip committee of s.v. Watt

Definition of terms

Term	Definition
Event/activity	Everything organized by the study trip committee of s.v. Watt. This includes the study trip, excursions, evaluations, multi-day study trips, and other events organized by the study trip committee of s.v. Watt.
Study trip committee of s.v. Watt	The committee responsible for the organization and execution of study trips within study association Watt.
s.v. Watt / s.a. Watt	Study association Watt, The study association based in Enschede representing students of Electrical Engineering, Applied Physics, Computer Science and Engineering, and Nanotechnology.
Member study trip committee	A person who is a member of the study trip committee of s.v. Watt and is recognizable as a member by committee clothing.
Study trip	An event organized for a group of members involving a multi-day visit to a foreign country with the primary purpose of visiting companies and/or educational institutions. Such trips shall also include recreational and social activities.
Latecomer	Any Participant who fails to arrive at the designated location of an activity at the specified time, regardless of the circumstances.
Participant	Any individual who has officially registered for the study trip and is in attendance, excluding members of the Study Trip Committee.
Driver	Any individual operating a vehicle in the context of an activity or the Study Trip.

Preface

- 5 This document sets forth the terms and conditions applicable to any Study Trip organized by the s.v. Watt Study Trip Committee. These conditions are intended to clearly define the responsibilities of the Committee Members, to establish general house rules and codes of conduct for all participants, and to ensure the orderly and successful execution of the events.

General Rules and Conditions

- 10 Instructions provided by Committee Members shall be followed at all times. Non-compliance with these instructions may result in immediate exclusion from further participation in the activity or trip. In the event of exclusion, any additional costs incurred (including, but not limited to, travel expenses for the return journey) shall be at the sole expense and risk of the Participant.
- 15 ⚡ Participants shall treat one another with mutual respect and courtesy throughout the Study Trip. In the event of any ambiguity or disputes, the Committee's decision is final.
 - ⚡ During company visits, all communication and behaviour must be professional and respectful.
 - ⚡ The Committee is not responsible for transportation for recreational purposes or for any transport not explicitly specified in the official itinerary.
 - 20 ⚡ The group will not wait for Latecomers. This rule may only be waived if a prior agreement has been made between the Latecomer and the Committee.
 - ⚡ The Committee reserves the right to retain personal data provided during registration for as long as deemed necessary for the execution of the event and administrative purposes.
 - ⚡ The Committee reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions applicable to specific activities.
 - 25 ⚡ In cases where a provision or rule in this document is subject to multiple interpretations, the interpretation of the Committee Members shall prevail.
 - ⚡ Photos and videos may be taken during the Study Trip for promotional use within the association, unless a participant explicitly requests otherwise in advance.
 - ⚡ Dinner is not included in the total cost of the Study Trip and shall be at the Participant's own expense.
 - 30 ⚡ Not all meals are included in the total cost of the Study Trip. Only the meals specifically mentioned in the official itinerary are included; all other meals shall be at the Participant's own expense.
 - ⚡ Attendance is mandatory for all organized activities and preparatory meetings, unless an alternative arrangement has been agreed upon with the Committee.

Registration & Payment Regulations

- ⚡ All information provided by a member in the registration form for the study trip will be accessible to all members of the Study Trip Committee.
 - 40 ⚡ The applicable fee for the study trip must be paid in full no later than August 31, 2026. Payments must be transferred to the following account: NL10 RABO 0111 8864 65, held by Studievereniging Watt, stating the relevant invoice number. Failure to complete the payment by the specified deadline will result in the automatic disqualification and cancellation of the participant's registration for the study trip.
 - 45 ⚡ Cancellations must be submitted at least two full weeks prior to the departure date of the study trip. If a cancellation is made less than two full weeks before the departure date without a valid reason (e.g., illness, bereavement, or other emergencies), the registration fee will only be refunded if a suitable replacement participant can be found.
 - ⚡ Participants must cancel their registration exclusively by sending an email to studiereis@svwatt.com. Cancellations made through any other communication channels will be considered invalid.

50 Regulations Concerning Drivers

The drivers shall ensure that all participants and committee members arrive safely at their destination. In the event of unreasonable driving behaviour, the Study Trip Committee reserves the right to impose sanctions. These sanctions are to be determined at the discretion of the committee on-site. As the driver bears responsibility while driving, they hold authority within the vehicle they are operating at that time.

- ↕ The driver is liable for all occurrences within the vehicle they are operating while driving.
- ↕ The driver is responsible for inspecting the vehicle for any damages and its technical condition prior to driving.
- ↕ The driver is obliged to report any existing damages or defects (such as broken lighting or a flat tire) to the committee member responsible for that day.
- ↕ The driver is responsible for carrying a valid driving licence whenever they are required to drive. If they are not in possession of their licence, they are prohibited from driving.
- ↕ It is strictly forbidden for the driver to consume alcoholic beverages if they are scheduled to operate a vehicle later that same day.

65 Regulations Concerning Health Matters

Participants are required to disclose all medically relevant information to the committee prior to the commencement of the study trip. This ensures that the committee can act appropriately in the event of medical emergencies and that relevant medical information can be provided to the appropriate authorities if necessary.

In the event that a participant fails to provide accurate or complete information, and should an incident occur during the study trip where it becomes evident that such information was withheld, the committee shall not be held liable for any resulting consequences. The matters to be reported are summarized below:

- ↕ Allergies
- ↕ Use of medication
- ↕ Chronic conditions
- ↕ Mobility limitations
- ↕ Recent medical procedures
- ↕ Pregnancy
- ↕ Communicable diseases
- ↕ Motion sickness (travel or car sickness)

It is the sole responsibility of the participant to determine whether specific documentation is required for international travel within the EU (such as for ADHD medication) and to carry such documentation at all times during the study trip.
